Welcome to Life After Meth, Inc.'s first newsletter! LAM is a 501c3 faith-based ministry based in Vincennes, Indiana. Thanks to Knox County Sheriff Mike Morris we begin our faith-based, 12 Step ministry in the Knox County Jail when an addict is at rock-bottom. LAM has two transition houses for the participants being released to our community, offering them a safe, clean place to begin a new, sober life. Each month we will update you on the progress of our ministry, highlighting some of our participant's progress and an opportunity to donate.



## Meet Carly(Cornwell) Curry

Carly joined the Life after Meth program in the Knox County Jail on March 10, 2014. She remained in the jail program until July 29, 2014 when she was released to go to the Women's LAM house. She flourished at the house and in September of 2015 she became the house manager. During her time at the house Carly:

- Obtained a full-time job at KCARC in the financial dept.
- Got her driver's license and bought a van to drive.
- Spoke at the Lightbearers Conference
- Went on the Walk to Emmaus and then returned as a speaker.
- Was one of the main speakers at the 2016 LAM Banquet.
- She was baptized at First Baptist Church.
- In July of 2016 after two years at the LAM House she moved into a home of her own and has joint custody of her children.

On April 22, 2017 Carly married Craig Curry.

The Women's House is in the process of building on a small addition that will consist of 2 bedrooms, a small living room and a bathroom.
